

Regulations for the Use of the Pool Area and Swimming Pool

at Western Camp Resort

1. The swimming pool is available exclusively to Guests using the hotel services. Accommodation at Western Camp Resort entitles Guests to free use of the swimming pool and constitutes acknowledgment and acceptance of the provisions of these regulations and the Resort Regulations.
2. Use of the pool area is permitted only during the operating hours of the pool area and only when supervisory staff are present. Before entering the pool, Users are required to leave outerwear and footwear beside the pool or on the sun loungers located next to the pool.
3. Entry to the pool is permitted only in generally accepted swimwear intended for pool use, namely:
 - women – a one-piece or two-piece swimsuit without elements that may pose a hazard,
 - men – close-fitting swim trunks without pockets or belts.
4. Children under 3 years of age may use the pool only while wearing special swim diapers intended for water use.
5. Devices that may be damaged (phones, watches, etc.) as well as items with sharp edges that may pose a hazard (e.g., jewelry) should be left in the accommodation units. Guests are advised to leave valuable items in their accommodation. The staff and management of Western Camp Resort shall not be held responsible for lost or stolen items.
6. Before using the pool complex, Users must thoroughly wash their bodies under a shower – either in the private bathroom assigned to their accommodation or in the public sanitary facilities located on the Resort premises.
7. After each use of the toilet, Users are required to thoroughly wash their bodies under a shower before re-entering the pool.
8. Children under 13 years of age may stay in the pool area only under the constant and active supervision of an adult. Parents or legal guardians bear full responsibility for the safety of children under their care. Supervision provided by the Resort staff is organizational in nature and does not replace individual parental or guardian supervision.
9. The pool may not be used by persons who:
 - are in a health condition that may pose a risk to themselves or other Users,
 - suffer from upper respiratory tract illnesses or breathing difficulties,
 - have unhealed wounds or skin diseases (e.g., fungal infections, skin lesions),
 - suffer from epilepsy or infectious diseases,
 - are allergic to disinfectants or chlorine,

- suffer from circulatory system disorders,
 - suffer from urinary or excretory system disorders.
10. Persons with limited mobility and pregnant women use the pool area at their own risk and with particular caution.
11. The following are prohibited within the pool area:
- bringing alcoholic beverages or food products,
 - bringing glass containers, sharp tools, or other dangerous objects,
 - chewing gum,
 - smoking tobacco products and electronic cigarettes,
 - consuming food or beverages in the water,
 - contaminating the water or throwing objects into the pool,
 - running within the pool area,
 - diving or jumping into the pool,
 - pushing or throwing other persons into the water,
 - relieving oneself in the pool,
 - using vulgar language,
 - bringing animals into the pool area,
 - using the pool while under the visible influence of alcohol or intoxicating substances,
 - using rescue equipment contrary to its intended purpose,
 - initiating false alarms.
12. In the case of organized groups, the group supervisor is responsible for the participants' behavior.
13. Any person who intentionally or unintentionally contaminates the pool may be charged with the costs of water replacement. In the case of children, responsibility lies with the child's guardian.
14. Any injuries, dangerous incidents, or irregularities must be immediately reported to the supervising pool staff or Resort personnel.
15. Resort staff may temporarily restrict access to the pool area due to the number of persons currently using the pool or for safety reasons.
16. Persons violating the provisions of these regulations or the Resort Regulations may be removed from the pool area without the possibility of re-entry.
17. Users are required to comply with all orders, prohibitions, warnings, and information displayed on information boards located within the pool area. Such notices constitute an integral part of these regulations.
18. Matters not regulated herein shall be governed by the Western Camp Resort Regulations.
